Everyone Has A Name: A No-Cost-Everyone-Can-Participate Spirit Week

AWSL Goal and Objective: Learn and practice techniques for building and strengthening relationships.

Monday: Everyone Has A Name

Students and staff make name tags first period with supplies provided by ASB. Students are encouraged to wear their nametag all week. For an inexpensive nametag, use shoelaces as lanyards, plastic name holders, cut-to-size cardstock for the nametag and crayons to decorate. Ask students to use their favorite colors to design their nametag, encourage students to consciously call people by their names all week and to talk to people they don't know as well as others.

Conversation Starters

- How is your favorite color incorporated into your life?
- When do you first remember having a favorite color?
- What is the story of your name?

Tuesday: Nobody Eats Alone

Set up a <u>Mix It Up at Lunch Day</u> or just encourage everyone to eat with someone new at lunch. Utilize your student leaders to make sure no one is eating by themselves. At the lunch tables, encourage students to play the mixer *Traffic Jam* (see page 2).

Wednesday: Favorite T-shirt Day Selfie Day

Students and staff are encouraged to wear a t-shirt that expresses something they have an interest in (sport team, band, movie, tourist destination) or a type of t-shirt (color, brand, camo, stripes). Then, at selfie stations set up around the school (or go old school and take a polaroid!), students are encouraged to group together with others that have a similar shirt to take a selfie. The photos can then be displayed on a wall and awards can be given out for categories (like largest group, most esoteric t-shirt, farthest away tourist destination, biggest sport fan club).

Thursday: Random Acts of Kindness

Students and staff are encouraged to complete random acts of kindness all day (RAK). A banner can be set up in commons or lunchroom where students can use Post-Its to give shout outs to someone who completed a RAK for them on this day. At the end of the day, Post-It notes will be picked random prize drawings.

Friday: School Pride

Students and staff are encouraged to wear school colors during the day and sing the school fight song as they walk to class during passing time!
